The next regularly scheduled meeting of the  
Van Buren Township Downtown Development Authority  
will be held on Tuesday, July 27, 2021 at 5:30 p.m.

To mitigate the spread of COVID-19, protect the public health and provide essential protections to Van Buren Township residents, VBT DDA Board members and DDA staff, the July 27<sup>th</sup> meeting will be conducted in compliance with the directive from the Wayne County Local Public Health Department. On June 14, 2021 an extension was granted for the Local Public Health Emergency Epidemic Order (originally issued March 20, 2021) for the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pursuant to section 333.2453 of the Public Health Code of the State of Michigan. As it has been determined that it is necessary to continue to protect the public health from further transmission of COVID-19 within Wayne County. The jurisdiction of the Wayne County Local Public Health Department is Wayne County, except for the City of Detroit.

COVID-19 remains an imminent threat to the public throughout Wayne County. In the jurisdiction of the Wayne County Local Public Health Department, meetings of governmental bodies must be accessible to all members of the public, vaccinated and unvaccinated. Therefore, the Wayne County Local Public Health Department has extended the originally issued emergency order to allow a local body to continue to hold remote meetings under the Open Meetings Act until December 31, 2021.

In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, reasonable accommodations will be made with advance notice.
